Primary health care providers play a key role in enabling high quality, efficient, safe and accessible healthcare.

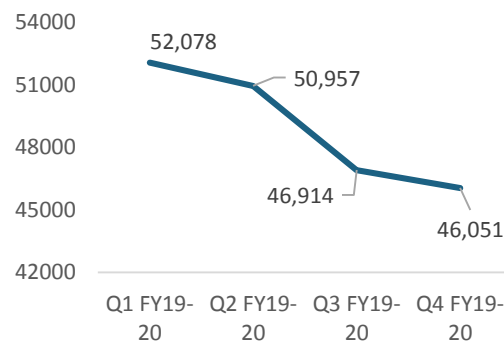
As of March 31, 2020

152,233 Nova Scotians have been placed with a primary care provider through the Need a Family Practice registry and other routes as tracked by NSHA since the registry was introduced.

Overall Patient Experience

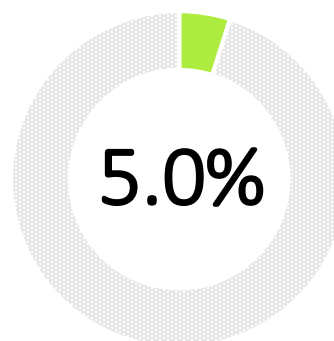


95% of respondents feel their health care team helped them feel confident in their ability to take care of their own health
